FEDERAL HOUSING FINANCE BOARD

Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis 1996 District Priority
for the Affordable Housing Program

WHEREAS, Subsection 10(j) of the Federal Home Loan Bank Act (Bank Act) (12 U.S.C. § 1430(j)) requires that each Federal Home Loan Bank (FHLBank) establish an Affordable Housing Program (AHP); and


WHEREAS, the Federal Housing Finance Board (Finance Board) has adopted a regulation, 12 C.F.R. Part 960, for the operation of the AHP by the FHLBank, that authorizes a FHLBank to include, among the criteria used to score program applications, a FHLBank objective that is recommended by the FHLBank's Advisory Council, adopted by the FHLBank's board of directors, and approved by the Finance Board (12 C.F.R. § 960.5(b)(7)). This objective is commonly known as a FHLBank's district priority or AHP priority; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 1995, the Board of Directors of the Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis (Indianapolis FHLBank) adopted a district priority recommended by its Advisory Council for 1996; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with regulatory requirements, the Indianapolis FHLBank has submitted the district priority it adopted for 1996 to the Finance Board for approval; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, that based on the factors set forth above and the authority provided in 12 C.F.R. § 960.5(b)(7), the Indianapolis FHLBank's 1996 AHP priority for "projects that meet a documented critical housing need as a part of a planned community revitalization strategy, which leads to current or future home ownership, which leverages Affordable Housing Program funds with other funds such as Community Investment Program funds, or which promotes economic integration" as adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Indianapolis FHLBank on December 15, 1995, and evidenced in Attachment A to this resolution, is approved.
