Dear Chairman Rosenfield:

In March, the Federal Housing Finance Board issued a proposed rule that would change the capital structure of the Federal Home Loan Banks by imposing limits on the amount of excess stock that a Federal Home Loan Bank can have outstanding and by prescribing a minimum retained earnings threshold. We recognize that dividend payments by the Federal Home Loan Banks would be substantially reduced under the proposal. For many community banks, those dividends account for a significant percentage of their earnings.

Based upon my review of the proposal and feedback received, I urge you and the other members of the Board to withdraw or substantially amend the proposed rule. If the Board believes that a capital restructuring plan is necessary, then please consider more flexible approaches that minimize the disruptive effect upon member institutions of the Federal Home Loan Banks.
