I believe that, first of all, it will not help the people who are in danger of losing their homes because the plan is to refinance mortgages of those who are most likely to continue payments. I also believe this is a misuse of eminent domain. It is also unfair to the majority of homeowners in California who have suffered a loss in the value of their homes. Furthermore, I don't understand how a profit is to be made, when mortgagees would be paying less in the end than they are now. The profit appears to come from questionable fees that will be charged to the mortgagees. I think this kind of forced devaluation will not be good for the general economy, or for people who wish to buy homes, or for the investment community. Lastly, I fear a mismanagement of funds which will, once again, leave the taxpayer on the hook.
