FEDERAL HOUSING FINANCE BOARD SETS DISCLOSURE HEARING, RESCHEDULES DECEMBER BOARD MEETING

The Federal Housing Finance Board will hold a public hearing at 2 p.m., Monday, Dec. 2, to take testimony from representatives of the Federal Home Loan Banks on enhanced disclosure under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

Only directors and executives of Federal Home Loan Banks may present testimony in person. Other interested parties can submit written testimony.

The hearing will take place in the Board Room of the Federal Housing Finance Board building at 1777 F Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

Banks and others submitting only written views must submit them in electronic form to Elaine Baker, Secretary to the Finance Board, at BakerE@FHFB.Gov no later than 2 p.m. Monday, December 2, 2002, and must also deliver 50 copies to the hearing location before the start of the hearing.

Federal Housing Finance Board Chairman John T. Korsmo also announced that the regular December meeting of the Board is being rescheduled from Dec. 11 to Dec. 20. The meeting time is 10 a.m.

The move accommodates schedules of Finance Board directors and allows more time to prepare for the lengthy agenda anticipated at the meeting.
