Samuel Frumkin serves as FHFA's Executive Secretary. He brings an extensive familiarity with FHFA's statutory requirements from his work on a wide range of regulatory, policy, and supervisory issues related to FHFA's regulated entities since joining FHFA's Division of Housing Mission and Goals in 2014. Prior to joining FHFA, Frumkin worked for the Consumer Protection

Bureau (CFPB), where he was one of the key drafters of the Bureau's Guidance on Privacy Laws and Reporting Financial Abuse of Older Adults, which was jointly issued by eight federal agencies in September 2013.

Previously, Frumkin worked in the Consumer Compliance Division of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) and both the Community Affairs Department and Economics Department of the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC).

He is a graduate of the Kennedy School of Government and Yale University.
