Andre D. Galeano – *Deputy Director* *Division of Bank Regulation (DBR)*

As head of FHFA’s Division of Bank Regulation, Galeano oversees all activities related to the regulation and supervision of the nation’s Federal Home Loan Banks. Galeano has served in various capacities at FHFA since 2002, including as Associate Director of examinations for the FHLBanks. He was the Examiner-in-Charge over Fannie Mae in 2012, and as FHFA’s Associate Director of Credit Risk in 2011.

Beginning in 2002, Galeano worked for the Federal Housing Finance Board as a senior bank examiner and the examiner-in-charge of the

Federal Home Loan Bank of New York. He was promoted to portfolio manager in 2005, overseeing a team of examiners and several Federal Home Loan Banks and the Office of Finance.

Galeano is a self-described “lifelong bank examiner,” having begun his career with the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) in 1992 as an assistant bank examiner in the Manhattan Field Office. He was commissioned in August 1995 and became an FDIC case manager in 1997.

He is a graduate of Pace University with a double major in finance and economics. He graduated from the Stonier Graduate School of Banking with Distinction Honors, and is a graduate of the Federal Executive Institute Leadership for a Democratic Society.

Galeano resides in McLean, Virginia, with his wife, Mirna, an elementary school teacher, and two children, Breeana and Naethan.
