Lawrence Stauffer – *Acting Chief Operating Officer Office of the Chief Operating Officer (OCOO)*

As FHFA's COO, Stauffer directs all day-to-day FHFA operations, including facilities management, contingency planning, continuity of operations, financial and strategic planning, budgeting, contracting, hiring and human resources management, information technology, quality assurance, internal and external communications, and coordination with the FHFA Office of the Inspector General.

Stauffer has been at FHFA since its creation in 2008, and has held several positions, including Principal Accounting Examiner, Associate Chief

Accountant, Special Advisor, and his current position of Acting COO. Before FHFA, he worked for two of its predecessors, the Office of Federal Housing Enterprise Oversight from 2006 to 2008; and the Federal Housing Finance Board from 1995 through 2000. He also spent six years at the U.S. Department of the Treasury, working on privatizing student loan GSE Sallie Mae.

Stauffer began his career in the early 1990s as a bank examiner with the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation. He holds a bachelor of science in Finance from the University of Maryland at College Park, is a Certified Public Accountant and a Chartered Financial Analyst charter holder. Stauffer and his wife reside in Maryland and have two children.
