Lynn Fisher serves as the Deputy Director of the Division of Research and Statistics (DRS) at the Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA). As the Deputy Director, Fisher is responsible for using economics, research, and data analytics to enhance FHFA's regulatory policy, supervision, and oversight.

Fisher joined FHFA in 2019 from the American Enterprise Institute where she was a Resident Scholar and Co-Director of the Housing Center. Prior to that, she was the Vice President of Research and Economics at the Mortgage

Bankers Association and served on the faculty of the University of North Carolina, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Washington State University. She received her Ph.D. in Business Administration from Penn State University, where she concentrated in real estate finance and microeconomics. Fisher's work has been published in a variety of academic and industry outlets, and she speaks regularly to academic and industry audiences.
