## **Robert Fishman** – *Deputy Director* *Division of Conservatorship (DOC)*

Fishman is responsible for leading, coordinating and clarifying, as needed, FHFA and Enterprise (Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac) activities related to the conservatorship and FHFA's Strategic Plan for the Enterprise Conservatorship. Previous to this position, Robert served as Senior Associate Director (Operating Officer) of the Division of Conservatorship, where he was responsible for overseeing the Office of Strategic Initiatives, the Office of Asset Conservatorship, the division's risk management and budget activities, and is the division representative on the agency's Executive Committee on Internal Controls. He also oversaw the development and implementation of the Common Securitization Platform and the Single Security Initiative.

Prior to joining FHFA in December 2012, Fishman was the Managing Executive of the Office of Compliance Inspections and Examinations at the Securities and Exchange Commission, where he had responsibility for the operational functions (strategic planning, budget, information technology, human resource management, risk and surveillance analytics, etc.) of the National Exam Program. Previously, he was the Chief Risk Officer at the Government National Mortgage Association (Ginnie Mae) and he spent 15 years at Freddie Mac, where he held a variety of senior positions related to business operations and controls. He previously worked at the U.S. Department of the Treasury and the Office of Management and Budget.
