D102 – Regulatory Audits

This function conducts oversight of risk measurement, management, and controls of the regulated entities (the Federal National Mortgage Association (Fannie Mae), the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation (Freddie Mac), and the Federal Home Loan Bank System, which includes the 11 Banks and the Office of Finance) through risk-based examinations of their operations to ensure they are operating in compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and safety and soundness standards. The oversight includes assessing and rating the quality and effectiveness of regulated entities practices, performance, operations, risk management practices, accounting, and includes the oversight of formal agreements and orders, special reviews, and targeted examinations. These oversight and assessment activities require compiling, analyzing, and assessing very complex financial, non-financial, risk, and operational data to evaluate the condition and performance of the regulated entities, as well as communicating regulatory requirements, policies, and other issues. The results of the assessment may ultimately lead to the imposition of sanctions on the regulated entities through the agency's statutory authority. In addition, examination results and conclusions are formally reported to the United States Congress on an annual basis. Also, the function advises regulated entities' management of opportunities to improve or enhance operations or risk management and, as appropriate, communicates observations and recommendations to the regulated entities' Boards of Directors and executive management. This function develops and implements Agency processes for assessing regulated entities' management and risk levels. It also executes studies, special projects, and investigations related to safety and soundness and compliance issues. Accurate evaluation of the regulated entities requires expert knowledge of their activities and risks acquired over an extended period of time.

Reason Code A Justification

FHFA continues to designate its administrative support functions (B000, C000, D000, W000, and Y000) as commercial with reason code A. Positions assigned to these codes require access to, and are responsible for maintaining confidential, propriety non-public information, data, and documents. The misuse of this information poses an unacceptable risk to the performance of FHFA's mission.
