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FHFA House Price Index Up 0.2 Percent in April

Washington, DC – U.S. house prices rose in April, up **0.2 percent** on a seasonally adjusted basis from the previous month, according to the Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA) monthly House Price Index (HPI). The previously reported 0.7 percent increase in March was revised upward to reflect a 0.8 percent increase.

The FHFA monthly HPI is calculated using home sales price information from mortgages sold to, or guaranteed by, Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac. From April 2015 to April 2016, house prices were up **5.9 percent**. Since October 2015, the national house price index level has surpassed the prior peak level from March 2007.

For the nine census divisions, seasonally adjusted monthly price changes from March 2016 to April 2016 ranged from **-0.7 percent** in the Middle Atlantic division to **+1.4 percent** in the New England division. The 12-month changes were all positive, ranging from **+1.7 percent** in the Middle Atlantic division to **+8.6 percent** in the Pacific division.




Seasonally Adjusted and Unadjusted Monthly Appreciation Rates Purchase-Only Index for U.S.

Monthly House Price Index for U.S.


Purchase-Only, Seasonally Adjusted Index, January 1991 - Present


Cumulative Seasonally Adjusted Price Change Relative to the March 2007 Peak for the U.S. Purchase-Only, Seasonally Adjusted Index
