			released by US Military Departments strongly suggest, if not demonstrate that the litigation expenses of corporate MHPI partners are funded by the Operation & Maintenance ("O&M") accounts of their MHPI projects. In other words, funds that are supposed to be used to repair & maintain privatized military housing are being used to defend corporate MHPI partners relative to legal claims that military family residents have filed against them for allegedly failing to disclose or mitigate environmental health hazards in and around their assigned homes and communities. In fact, FOIA records also suggest MHPI O&M funds were used to fund the reported Strategic Lawsuit Against Public Participation or SLAPP suit that corporate and US government partners of one MHPI PPV/LLC pursued against a former military family resident (see attachment) and advocate for military families. If true, MHPI O&M funds are not accounted for or being used properly.
